# Darn Knit Hearts You!

Nothing says *I love you*  
like a bigger than big  
knit heart.



## Instructions

CO 1 st

Row 1 – K

Row 2 – Kfb (2 sts)

Row 3 – and all odd rows,

K across all sts

Row 4 – Kfb, Kfb (4 sts)

Row 6 – Kfb, K2, Kfb (6 sts)

Row 8 – Kfb, K4, Kfb (8 sts)

Row 2 – Cont. working  
only the sts just worked,  
K5, K2tog.

Row 3 – K4, K2tog

Row 4 – K3, K2tog

Row 5 – K2tog, K1,

K2tog.

BO.

Continue knitting odd rows and  
increasing 1 st on each end of  
even rows until you have 16 sts.  
Ending with an odd row.

1<sup>st</sup> bump of heart.

Row 1 - K2tog, K4, K2tog, turn  
work, leaving remaining sts on  
needle.

With new strand of roving  
repeat for 2<sup>nd</sup> bump of  
heart.

Weave in ends (hee hee  
hee) and hang it up!

## Materials

24 oz merino roving  
US35 Needles 3 feet long



We suggest cutting up a broom handle and  
sharpening the end! Who wants to sweep  
anyway?

## Gauge / Size

about 3 sts/ 4"

approximately 23"x 25"

## Abbreviations

**CO**=Cast on

**BO**=Bind off

**K**=Knit

**Kfb**=Knit front and back of stitch

**K2tog**=Knit 2 stitches together

**sts**=Stitches
