

## Darn Knit Hearts You!

Nothing says *I love you* like a bigger than big knit heart.



## **Instructions**

CO1st

Row 1 - K

Row 2 - Kfb (2 sts)

Row 3 – and all odd rows,

K across all sts

Row 4 – Kfb, Kfb (4 sts)

Row 6 - Kfb, K2, Kfb (6 sts)

Row 8 - Kfb, K4, Kfb (8 sts)

Continue knitting odd rows and

even rows until you have 16 sts.

increasing 1 st on each end of

Ending with an odd row.

1st bump of heart.

With new strand of roving repeat for 2<sup>nd</sup> bump of heart.

Row 2 – Cont. working

only the sts just worked,

Row 3 - K4, K2tog

Row 4 - K3, K2tog

Row 5 - K2tog, K1,

K5, K2tog.

K2tog. BO.

Weave in ends (hee hee hee) and hang it up!

Materials

24 oz merino roving US35 Needles 3 feet long

We suggest cutting up a broom handle and sharpening the end! Who wants to sweep anyway?

## Gauge / Size

about 3 sts/4"

approximately 23"x 25"

## **Abbreviations**

**CO**=Cast on

**BO**=Bind off

K=Knit

**Kfb**=Knit front and back of stitch

**K2tog**=Knit 2 stitches together

sts=Stitches
