# Darn Knit Quick and Bulky Mittens

It doesn't get much quicker or bulkier than these mittens.

Made with one skein of super bulky yarn, you can make a pair in a day!



## Instructions

With smaller needle, **CO 20** stitches and join in round, being careful not to twist when joining. Place marker – slip marker as you come to it.

**Rows 1- 10:** K1, P1 rib

**Rows 11 – 13:** Change to larger needle and K around

**Row 14:** K2, M1, K2, M1, K to end of round

**Row 15 and 16:** K all stitches

**Row 17:** K2, M1, K4, M1, K to end of round

**Row 18 and 19:** K all stitches

**Row 20:** K2, place 6 stitches on holder, cast 2 stitches onto right needle, K to end

**Rows 21 +:** Knit all rounds until hand measures about 9” from CO edge to top of your index finger

### Decrease top:

Next row: K1, K2tog, SSK, K6, K2tog, SSK, K5

Next row: K2tog, SSK, K4, K2tog, SSK, K4

Next row: K2tog, K4, K2tog, K4 (10 sts)

Move to 2 double pointed needles and bind off with Kitchener stitch

## Materials

US10 and 11 double points or magic loop

75-90 yards Super Bulky Yarn

Tapestry needle    Stitch holder

**Size** Hand measures about 4 inches across, height it to your liking!

**Gauge** 3 stitches per inch on US 10 in stockinette stitch

## Abbreviations

**K**=Knit

**CO**=Cast On

**BO**=Bind Off

**K2tog**=Knit 2 stitches together

**SSK**=slip first stitch from the left needle to the right needle purlwise, do the same with the second stitch, then going down through both stitches on right needle knit both slipped stitches off that needle

**M1**= Pick up the bar between the needles from back to front and knit through the back of the stitch

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# Darn Knit Quick and Bulky Mittens {page 2}

**Thumb:** Knit 6 stitches from holder onto 2 double pointed needles, with a 3<sup>rd</sup> needle, pick up and knit 4 stitches (1 from each side and 2 from the cast on edge of the thumb hole).

Next Row: Knit 8 rows or until when you put on the mitten the thumb is covered.

Next Row: K2tog around (5 sts)

Cut yarn, thread through remaining stitches and weave in ends!
