



Darn Knit Irish Gate Cowl

You really can't go wrong with this gorgeous pattern. Irish Gate would be lovely in Kelly green for St. Patrick's Day too!



Instructions

Pattern Repeat:

Row1: YO, K2tog, *YO, S1, K2, pass slip stitch over both K sts. Repeat from * until end of round

Row2: K entire round

Row3: K1, *S1, K2, Pass slip stitch over both stitches, YO. Repeat from * until one stitch remains, K1.

Row4: K entire round

Pattern:

CO 152 for larger size

CO 89 for small size

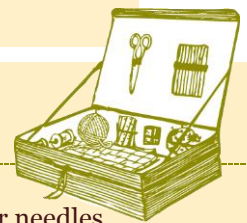
Place stitch marker and begin knitting in the round with set up round.

Set Up Round: K2, *YO, S1, K2, pass slip stitch over both K sts. Repeat from * until end of round.

Begin next round with Pattern Row 2 and continue with Pattern Repeat until cowl measures desired height ending with Row 1 or Row 3.

BO, weave in ends, put it on and think of your friends at DKA!

Materials



US11, 16" or 24" circular needles
1 skein Wexford Merino Silk by Three Irish Girls
colorway Luxor (60% silk, 40% merino)

Finished Sizes

Small Cowl- approx 22" diameter
Long Cowl- approx 50" diameter

Abbreviations

CO=Cast On **K2tog**= knit 2 together
St=stitches **S1**=slip next stitch as if to knit
K=knit
YO= Yarn Over
