Use your creativity to give a truly personal gift to a collegiate student living in foster care. The scarves are distributed as part of a Valentine's Day packet, along with school supplies.

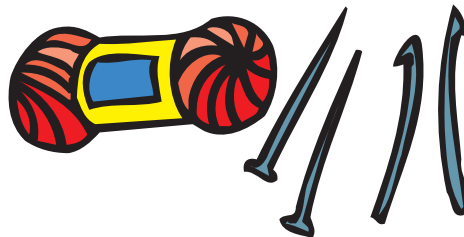
Who: Knitters and crocheters of all abilities. Must be able to knit or crochet.

You will receive a 20% discount at Darn Knit Anyway Yarn Shop at 423 Main Street South in Stillwater when you drop off a finished scarf. Darn Knit has a selection of worsted and bulky yarns specially chosen for this project, although you may use any red yarn to make the scarf. All scarves must meet the guidelines of the Red Scarf program, including being washable, 5" - 8" wide and approximately 60" long.
