# Darn Knit Silky Cowl

A little something soft  
and silky...



## Instructions

Cowl is worked holding one strand of each yarn together.

CO 120 sts, place marker, join in the round being careful not to twist the work.

**Row 1-6:** Knit, slipping marker as you come to it.

**Row 7-12:** \*YO, K2tog; repeat from \* to end of round. Slipping marker as you come to it.

**Row 13 - 15:** Knit, slipping marker as you come to it.

**Row 16-21:** \*YO, K2tog; repeat from \* to end of round. Slipping marker as you come to it.

**Row 22 - 24:** Knit, slipping marker as you come to it.

**Row 25-30:** \*YO, K2tog; repeat from \* to end of round slipping marker as you come to it.

**Row 31-36:** Knit, slipping marker as you come to it.

Cast off all stitches loosely...really loosely...you might even want to cast off with a larger sized needle.

## Materials



US11, 24" circular needles  
1 skein Alchemy Silk Purse  
1 Skein Rowan Kidsilk Haze

## Size

Approx 9" wide x 48" around

## Abbreviations

**CO**=Cast On  
**St**=stitches  
**K**=knit  
**YO**= Yarn Over  
**K2tog**= Knit 2 together
