

Stripy Steps Hat

Basic hat with a little zing.



Instructions

CO 56 sts with MC, PM and join in the round.

K2,P2 rib for 1.5"

Round 1: Change to CC and knit to marker.

Round 2: *K2, sl2 wyif; repeat

from * to marker

Round 3: knit

Round 4: RM, K1, PM, *K2,

sl2 wyif; repeat from * to

marker

Round 5: knit

Round 6: RM, k1, PM, *K2,

sl2 wyif; repeat from * to

marker

Round 7: change to MC and

knit to marker

Round 8: knit

Rounds 9 - 24: repeat rounds

1-8 twice more

Knit MC until hat measures between 5-6 inches or until it covers the ears. Remember, every head is different© **Shape Top in MC**

Round 1 (dec): *K2tog, k6;

repeat from * to marker.

Round 2: Knit

Round 3 (dec): *K2tog, k5

repeat from * to marker.

Round 4: Knit

Round 5 (dec): *K2tog, k4

repeat from * to marker.

Round 6: Knit

Round 7 (dec): *K2tog, k3

repeat from * to marker.

Round 8: Knit

Round 9 (dec): *K2tog, k2

repeat from * to marker.

Round 10: Knit

Round 11 (dec): *K2tog, k1

repeat from * to marker.

Round 12: Knit

Round 13 (dec): *K2tog repeat

from * to marker.

Cut yarn, thread yarn on tapestry needle and cinch closed. Weave

in ends.

Pop a pom pom on top if you

please!

Materials

US10 or 11, 16" circular needles US10 or 11 double pointed needles

2 skeins of Boston Yarn s

Pom pom is optional@

Size

US11 makes an adult size US10 makes a kiddo size

Gauge

12 sts/15 rows = 4" in stockinette on US11 16 sts/24 rows = 4" in stockinette on US10

Abbreviations

CO=Cast On

K=knit

P=purl

K2tog=knit 2 sts. together

Sl2 wyif = slip 2 stitches to the right needle as if

to purl while holding working yarn to the front

pm= place marker

rm=remove marker

MC = main color

CC = contrastic color
