



## Little Something More

Perfect cowl for someone who wants a “little something more” than just stockinette stitch!

### Materials

**Yarn:** 1 skein Lavender Lune Alpaca Merino 191 yards/100 grams

**Color Shown:** Woolstock

**Needle:** 24” US10

**Notions:** Stitch marker, Darning needle

### Instructions

Cast on 100 stitches. Place beginning of round marker.

**Rounds 1 – 6:** \*knit 2, purl 2 repeat from \* to marker.

**Round 7:** \*knit 7, k2tog, yo, k2, yo, ssk, knit 7. Repeat from \* to end of round.

**Round 8:** Knit to end.

Repeat rounds 7 & 8, 16 more times.

Repeat rounds 1 – 6

Bind off in pattern.

\*\*Place markers between repeats in round 7 if you need help staying on track.



### Finished Size & Gauge

26” circ x 11” tall – blocked  
16 sts x 25 rows = 4” in stockinette

### Abbreviations

k2tog=Knit the next 2 stitches together.  
yo = Yarnover  
Ssk = Slip, Slip, Knit



## Little Something More

### Finished Size & Gauge

26” circ x 11” tall – blocked  
16 sts x 25 rows = 4” in stockinette

### Abbreviations

k2tog=Knit the next 2 stitches together.  
yo = Yarnover  
ssk = Slip, Slip, Knit
