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# 3x3 Hat

3 Skeins of Quince & Co Puffin will get you 3 colorful hats! The choice is up to you on the style of brim and texture of the stripe!



## Instructions

Your three skeins of Puffin will get you three great hats if you use each color once as the MC, CC1 & CC2. You will have enough yarn left over to make a 4<sup>th</sup> hat or add pom poms!

**CO 45**—with MC yarn and smaller needle for Hat #1 & #3, larger needle for Hat #2. Place a marker and begin knitting in the round being careful not to twist the work. Slip marker as you come to it.

### Choose Your Brim:

#### Hat #1: Ribbed Brim

Rounds 1-5: \*(K3, P2) repeat from\* to end of round.

Rounds 6-11: Knit

#### Hat #2: Rolled Brim

Rounds 1-11: Knit

#### Hat #3: Seed Stitch Brim

Round 1: \*K1, P1; repeat from \* until last stitch, K1.

Round 2: \*P1, K1; repeat from \* until the last stitch, P1.

Repeat rounds 1 & 2 two more time a total of 6 rounds.

Knit 4 rounds.

## Materials

**Needles:** US 11 & 13 16" circular needles and US 13 dpn's or use magic loop technique for the decrease

**Yarn:** Quince & Co, *Puffin* 100% American wool; 112 yards=100g each. Shown in colors: Apricot, Bark & Belize.

**Notions:** stitch marker and tapestry needle

**Gauge** 10 sts = 4" stockinette st with US 13

**Size** Fits 19-22" head

## Abbreviations

**CO** = Cast on

**MC** = Main Color

**CC1** = Contrasting Color 1

**CC2** = Contrasting Color 2

**K** = Knit

**P** = Purl

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**K2tog** = Knit 2 stitches together

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## Pick Your Textured Stripe:

**Hat #1:** Switch to larger needle.

Round 1 & 2: Knit with CC1

Round 3: Knit with CC2

Round 4: Knit with MC

Round 5: Knit with CC1

Round 6: Knit with MC

Round 7: Knit with CC2

Round 8 & 9: Knit with CC1

Round 10: Knit with MC

**Hat #2:**

Round 1: Purl with CC1

Round 2: Knit with CC1

Round 3: Knit with CC2

Round 4: Knit with MC

Round 5: Knit with CC2

Round 6: Purl with CC1

Round 7: Knit with CC1

Round 8: Purl with MC

Round 9-11: Knit with MC

**Hat #3:** Switch to larger needle.

Round 1: With CC1 - \*K1, P1; repeat from \* until last st, K1.

Round 2: With CC1 - \*P1, K1; repeat from \* until last st, P1.

Round 3: With CC2 - \*K1, P1; repeat from \* until last st, K1.

Round 4: With CC2 - \*P1, K1; repeat from \* until last st, P1.

Round 5: With MC - \*K1, P1; repeat from \* until last st, K1.

Round 6 & 7: Knit with MC.

Round 8 & 9: Repeat round 3 & 4.

Round 10 & 11: Repeat round 1 & 2.

Round 12: With MC - \*P1, K1; repeat from \* until last st, P1.

## Begin decreasing:

Round 1: (Knit 7, k2tog) x5 (40 sts)

Round 2: Knit

Round 3: (K6, k2tog) x5 (35 sts)

Round 4: Knit

Round 5: (K5, k2tog) x5 (30 sts)

Round 6: Knit

Round 7: (K4, k2tog) x5 (25 sts)

Round 8: K2tog x12, k1 (13 sts)

Round 9: K2tog x 6, k1 (7 sts)

Leaving an 8" tail, cut yarn and thread through remaining 7 stitches. Cinch stitches together. Weave in ends
