

Darn Knit 10 Year Anniversary Hat

We are 10! We thought the best way to celebrate is with Cashmere! You will love the lightweight feel and warmth of this hat!

Instructions

With smaller needle and 1 strand of each yarn held together, cast on 90. Place a marker and join in the round.

Brim

Rounds 1-17: Work a (K1, P1) rib.

Body

Rounds 18+: Switch to larger needles. Knit until hat measures 6" from cast on edge.

Decrease - change to DPNs when needed.

Round 1: *K7, K2tog; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 2: Knit

Round 3: *K6, K2tog; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 4 & 5: Knit.

Round 6: *K5, K2tog; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 7 & 8: Knit.

Round 9: *K4, K2tog; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 10 & 11: Knit.

Round 12: *K3, K2tog; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 13: Knit.

Round 14: *K2, K2tog; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 15: *K1, K2tog; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 16: *K2tog; repeat from * to end of round.

Finishing

Break yarn leaving a 6" tail, thread through remaining stitches and cinch together. Weave in ends.



Materials

Yarns: 1 skein – Lang Yarns *Gordan*; 207yds/50g.

1 skein Rowan *Kidsilk Haze;* 230yds/25g.

Shown in Color 3 & shade 664

Needles: 16" circ US6 & 7, dpn US7

Notions:

Stitch marker & Tapestry needle

Size & Gauge

Average adult

18 sts = 4" in stockinette

Abbreviations

K=Knit

P=Purl

K2tog= knit next 2 stitches

together.
