



Progressive East End Project

Sneak a Peek Crochet

Instructions

With MC, work 112 single foundation chains. Slip stitch to 1st stitch to join in the round. Do not twist.

Section 1 (CC1)

Rounds 1 & 2 CC: Chain 2. (This will make it easier to find the chain at the end of the round). SC in each SC. Slip stitch to top of the chain 2 to end the round. (112 stitches)

Round 3 MC: (increase round) Chain 2. SC in next 3 SC, Bptr in 3rd sc of the foundation chain, Fptr around same stitch just worked. Skip 1 stitch; *SC in next 3 SC, Bptr in 4th foundation chain from last back post, Fptr around same stitch worked, skip 1 stitch; repeat from * until end of round. Join with a slip stitch to top of the chain 2 to end the round. (140 stitches)

Round 4 CC: (decrease round) Chain 2, *SC in next 3 SC, SC in next Bptr, skip 1 stitch; repeat from *until end of round. Join with a slip stitch to top of the chain 2 to end the round. (112 stitches)

Round 5 CC: Chain 2, SC in each SC. Slip stitch to top of the chain 2 to end the round. (112 stitches)

Round 6 MC: (increase round) Chain 2, SC in each next 3 sc, Bptr around Bptr of 3 rounds prior, Fptr around Fptr of 3 rounds prior. Skip 1 stitch; repeat from *until end of round. Join with a slip stitch to top of the chain 2 to end the round. (140 stitches)

Round 7 CC: Repeat round 4. (112 stitches)

Materials

Yarn:

MC: 370 yards of fingering weight.
Three Irish Girls Springvale Sock, Winter Birch
CC1 – CC5: 74 yards each
Three Irish Girls Springvale Sock
Guinness, Lucky Penny, Illusion, Windward & Bayside

Hook: USI / 5.5mm

Notions:

Tapestry needle

Finished Size 27" circ. x 8.5" blocked

Gauge

20 stitches x 20 rows = 4" in single crochet

Abbreviations

MC=Main Color

CC = Contrasting Color

SC = Single Crochet

Bptr = triple crochet around the back post

Fptr = triple crochet around the front post

Section 2 (CC2)

Round 1 CC: Chain 2. SC in each SC. Slip stitch to top of the chain 2 to end the round. (112 stitches)

Round 2 MC: (increase round) Chain 2, SC in each next 3 sc, Bptr around Bptr of 3 rounds prior, Fptr around Fptr of 3 rounds prior. Skip 1 stitch; repeat from *until end of round. Join with a slip stitch to top of the chain 2 to end the round. (140 stitches)

Round 3 CC: (decrease round) *SC in next 3 SC, SC in next Bptr, skip 1 stitch; repeat from * until end of round. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the chain 2 to end the round. (112 stitches)

Round 4 CC: Chain 2. SC in each SC. Slip stitch to top of the chain 2 to end the round. (112 stitches)

Round 5 – 7: repeat rounds 2, 3, & 4

Rounds 8 – 9: repeat round 2 & 3

For **Section 3 (CC3)** & **Section 4 (CC4)** repeat section 2 using the corresponding contrasting color.

Section 5 (CC5)

Repeat rounds 1 – 8 in previous sections.

Round 9 MC: Chain 2, *SC in next 3 SC, SC in next Bptr, skip 1 stitch; repeat from * until end of round. Join with a slip stitch to top of the chain 2 to end the round. Fasten off. (112 stitches)

Finishing

Weave in ends with a tapestry needle and block.
