## Sneak a Peek Knit

### Instructions

Using waste yarn, provisionally cast on 164 stitches. Place marker and join in the round.

With US 4, knit 1 round with MC.

#### **Textured side of cowl**

Round 1 CC: K1, P1

Round 2 MC: K

Round 3 CC: P1, K1

Round 4 MC: K

Round 5 CC: K1, P1

Round 6 MC: K

Round 7 CC: P1, K1

Round 8 MC: K

Round 1 MC: P1, K1

Round 2 CC: K

Round 3 MC: K1, P1

Round 4 CC: K

Round 5 MC: P1, K1

### Materials

#### **Yarn:**

MC: 370 yards of fingering weight.

Three Irish Girls Springvale Sock, Tres Chic

CC1 – CC5: 74 yards each

Three Irish Girls Springvale Sock

Guinness, Lucky Penny, Illusion, Windward & Bayside

**Needles:** US2 & 4 – 24” circular needle.

#### **Notions:**

Stitch marker

Tapestry needle

Waste yarn & crochet hook for provisional cast on

**Finished Size** 28” circ x 9” blocked, folded and seamed.

### Gauge

24 stitches x 36 rows = 4” in stockinette stitch

24 stitches x 41 rows = 4” in textured stitch

### Abbreviations

**MC**=Main Color

**CC** = Contrasting Color

**K** = Knit

**P** = Purl

Section 6 (CC3): Repeat section 2

Section 7 (CC4): Repeat section 3

Section 8 (CC4): Repeat section 4

Section 9 (CC5): Repeat section 5

Section 10 (CC5): Repeat section 2

Next round MC: Knit

This ends the textured side of the cowl.

**Striped side of cowl**

MC: Purl 1 round (turning round)

Switch to US2 needles.

MC: Knit 15 rounds

CC1: Knit 6 rounds

MC: Knit 5 rounds

CC2: Knit 6 rounds

MC: Knit 5 rounds

CC3: Knit 6 rounds

MC: Knit 5 rounds

CC4: Knit 6 rounds

MC: Knit 5 rounds

CC5: Knit 6 rounds

MC: Knit 15 rounds

**Finishing**

Break yarn leaving 4x the circumference of the cowl for grafting.

Place provisional stitches onto the US4 needle.

Fold the striped side of the project to the inside of the textured side. The working yarn should be attached to the inside needle. Use Kitchener in garter to close seam.
