



Versa Cowl

Instructions

Cast on 110 stitches. Place a beginning of the round marker. Cowl will be worked in the round, joining in first round.

With MC: Purl 3 rounds.

With MC: Knit 1 round.

Broken seed stitch pattern:

Round 1 with CC: K1, P1

Round 2 with MC: K

Round 3 with CC: P1, K1

Round 4 with MC: K

Round 5 with CC: K1, P1

Round 6 with MC: K

Round 7 with CC: P1, K1

Round 8 with MC: K

Round 9 with CC: K1, P1

Round 10 with MC: K

Round 11 with CC: P1, K1

Round 12 with MC: K

Round 13 with CC: K1, P1

Round 14 with MC: K

Round 15 with CC: P1, K1

Repeat rounds 1 – 15 of broken seed stitch 3 more times, switching MC and CC each repeat. Repeat 2 begins with MC, Repeat 3 begins with CC, Repeat 4 begins with MC.

With CC: Knit 1 round.

With CC: Purl 4 rounds.

Striped pattern:

With MC: Knit 3 rounds.

With CC: Knit 3 rounds.

Repeat above 6 rounds 8 more times for a total of 54 rows. Repeat above rows as needed for length. We found our row gauge was larger in stockinette stitch.

With MC: Knit 1 round.

With MC: Purl 3 rounds.

Bind off. Weave in ends with a tapestry needle.



Materials

Yarns: 1 skein each of 2 colors – Malabrigo Rios; 210yds/100g.

Needles: US8, 24” circular

Notions: Stitch marker & Tapestry needle.

Size & Gauge

Flat 12.5” x 17.5”

18 sts = 4” in stockinette

Abbreviations

K=Knit

P=Purl

MC= Main Color

CC= Contrasting Color
