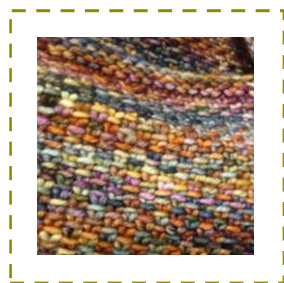




Linen Stitch Cowl

Instructions

Cast on 277 stitches with smaller needle, loosely.
Working flat, Knit 4 rows.
Begin working linen stitch in the round. No beginning of round marker needed

Linen Stitch: Knit on larger needle
Repeat (K1, Sl1wyif) until cowl measures 4.25 inches. Place marker.

Work last rows with smaller needle, purl 1 round, knit 1 round, and purl 1 round. Bind off loosely. Seam beginning first 4 rows together. Weave in ends and seam up the 4 knit rows.

Note: When working the Linen Stitch in the round, you will be working the stitch the opposite of what you see on your needle. If you see a Knit – you will Sl1wyif. If you see a Sl1wyif – you will Knit.

Materials

Yarn: 1 skein – Malabrigo, *Arroyo*;
100% Superwash Merino Wool.
335yds = 100 gr.
color shown 862 Piedras
Needle: US 6 & 10 - 24” or 32” circular
Notion: tapestry needle

Size

Approx. 5”x60” after blocking

Gauge

18 stitches/4” in garter

Abbreviations

k=knit

Sl1wyif=slip next stitch as if to purl with yarn in front.
