



# Aimee's Simple Shawl

## Instructions

Garner Tab Cast On with MC.

**Set up Row 1:** (RS) K2, YO, K1, M1R, PM, K1, PM, M1L, K1, YO, K2

**Set up Row 2:** (WS) K2, YO, purl to 2 stitches before end of row, YO, K2.

**Row 1:** (RS) K2, YO, knit to marker, M1R, SM, K1, SM, M1L, knit to 2 stitches before end of row, YO, K2.

**Row 2:** (WS) K2, YO, purl to 2 stitches before end of row, YO, K2  
Repeat **Rows 1 & 2** in MC – 12 more times. Break MC.

**CC Section** (12 row section) Join CC.

**Row 1 and all odd rows:** (RS) K2, YO, knit to marker, M1R, SM, K1, SM, M1L, knit to 2 stitches before end of row, YO, K2.

**Row 2 & 12:** (WS) K2, YO, knit to 2 stitches before end of row, YO, K2.

**Row 4, 6, 8 & 10:** (WS) K2, YO, purl to 2 stitches before end of row, YO, K2.  
Break CC.

**MC Section** (16 row section) Join MC.

**Row 1:** (RS) K2, YO, knit to marker, M1R, SM, K1, SM, M1L, knit to 2 stitches before end of row, YO, K2.

**Row 2:** (WS) K2, YO, purl to 2 stitches before end of row, YO, K2.  
Repeat **Rows 1 & 2** in MC – 14 more times. Break MC.

**Repeat CC & MC Sections as follows:**

CC Section  
MC Section  
CC Section  
MC Section  
CC Section

**Garner Edge** Join MC

**Row 1:** (RS) K2, YO, knit to marker, M1R, SM, k1, SM, M1L, knit to 2 stitches before end of row, YO, K2.

**Row 2:** (WS) K2, YO, knit to 2 stitches before end of row, YO, K2.

Repeat **Rows 1 & 2** working in colors as follows:  
CC, MC, CC

Bind off in MC and weave in ends.



## Materials

**Yarn:** approx. 300 yards each of 2 sport weight yarns.

Sample: 1 skein of each Juniper Moon Farms, *Summer Solstice*.

Queensland, *Dungarees*.

**Needle:** US 5 – 40" circular for length

**Notions:** 2 markers, Tapestry Needle

**Size** 72" long x 23" deep

**Gauge** 18 stitches/4" in garter

## Abbreviations

K – Knit

P – Purl

M1R – Make one right

M1L – Make one left

YO – Yarn over

PM – Place Marker

SM – Slip Marker

MC – Main Color

CC – Contrasting Color

### Garner Tab Cast On

Cast on 2 stitches, knit 7 rows. When you've completed row 7 don't turn your work.

Simply rotate your piece 90 degrees and pick up 3 stitches along the edge of the tab you've just made. Turn another 90 degrees and pick up 2 stitches along the original cast on edge. You'll have 7 stitches on your needle.
