

Minnesconsin Cowl





Instructions

Cast on 120, place maker and join in the round. Work a (k2 x p2) rib for a total of 8 rounds. Knit 3 rounds.

The body of the cowl is worked by knitting every stitch. You'll work the Dandelion Stitch every time the working yarn changes to the color burst section. When the working yarn begins to change color, work 4 or 5 stitches and then work Dandelion Stitch (see directions below). Going forward you'll knit every stitch until you come to another color burst section OR you resolve a Dandelion Stitch from the previous row (see directions below). When cowl measures 8" from cast on edge, knit 3 rounds. Work a (k2 x p2) rib for a total of 8 rounds. Bind off in pattern. Block. Attach tag with MN or WI showing and go visit a State Park!

Dandelion Stitch

Insert right needle 2 sts to the left, and down 3 sts. Pull up a loop with your right needle. *K2, insert needle through the same stitch to pull up another loop. * Repeat from * to * one more time.

Resolve Dandelion Stitch

When you get to the Dandelion Stitch from the previous row, K2tog (this is the stitch before the dandelion stitch, together with the first stitch of the Dandelion Stitch) K1, K2tog, K1, K2tog.

Notes

If the color burst section lands on top of another Dandelion Stitch, feel free to skip it.

Materials

Yarn: 1 skein Hazel Knits Lively DK;

275 yds/130g.

Colorway: Interstate Park MN Yarn Shop

Hop 2022

Needles: US6 - 24" Circular

Notions: Stitch marker, tapestry needle,

leather tag.

Size & Gauge

10" tall x 25" circumference 19 sts x 30 rows = 4" on a US6 blocked

Abbreviations

K=knit

P=purl

K2tog=knit the next 2 stitches together **Sts**=Stitches
