



Majestic Star

Perfect petit shawl for cruising down the St. Croix River. This triangular shawl is crocheted with DC Cross stitches. It ends with an Arch boarder.

Instructions

Body:

Chain 6.

Row 1: DC in 5th chain from hook, DC in 4th chain from hook crossing in front of initial DC made (one DC cross made). DC in last chain. Turn. [See note below.](#)

Row 2: Ch. 3 (counts as a DC here and throughout pattern). Skip 1st DC. DC cross across row until reaching the turning chain. 2 DC in the top of the turning chain. Turn

Row 3: Ch. 3. DC cross around first two DC of previous row (reminder 2nd DC of first cross will be into the top of the first DC of row). Continue DC cross stitch across row. DC in turning chain. Turn

Repeat **rows 2-3** until you have 85 stitches (Turning chain at start of row and 41 DC crosses and 2 DC in last stitch of the row) ending with a row 2.

Arch Stitch Border:

Row 1: Ch 1. SC in 1st DC, SC in next DC, * Ch 3, skip next 3 stitches, SC in each of next 3 stitches; rep from * to last 5 stitches; Ch 3, skip next 3 stitches, SC in last DC and top of turning chain, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, SC in same stitch, * skip 1 SC, 7 DC in next Ch 3 space, skip 1 SC, SC in next SC; rep from * to end; turn.

Row 3: Ch 4, skip 1st SC and 2 DC, * SC in each of next 3 DC, ch3, skip (2 DC, 1 DC, 2 DC); rep from * to last 5 DC and SC; SC in each of next 3 DC, Ch 1, skip 2 DC, DC in SC, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, 3 DC in Ch 1 space, * skip 1 SC, SC in next SC, skip 1 SC, 7 DC in next Ch 3 space; rep from * to last 3 SC and Ch 4 space; skip 1 SC, SC in next SC, skip 1 SC, 4 DC in Ch 4 space, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, SC in same stitch, SC in next DC, * Ch 3, skip (2 DC, 1 SC, 2 DC), SC in each of next 3 DC; rep from * to last 2 DC, 1 SC, 3 DC and turning chain; Ch 3, skip (2 DC, 1 SC, 2 DC), SC in last DC, SC in top of ch4, turn.

Repeat **rows 2-5** until you run out of yarn, end with either row 2 or 4. Fasten off. Weave in ends and block as preferred. Style with a shawl pin or tuck tail in the ripple holes.

Note: After first row, DC are worked in the spaces between DC – not in the tops of stitches. The exception is the second DC on the first cross of row 3 and further odd rows which will be worked in the top of the first DC of the row below.



Materials

Yarn: 1 skein Lavender Lune Fingering; 437 yards/100 grams.

Hook: H (5.0 mm)

Notions: darning needle

Size & Gauge

11 sts and 9 rows = 4" of DC Crosses.

Blocked to 40" long and 17" deep at Arch Border.

Abbreviations

Ch = Chain

SC = Single crochet

DC = Double crochet

DC cross = Skip first DC and DC in the space between crosses. DC in space before first DC of the cross, crossing in front of previous DC made. See chart below.
