



It's Just a Knit Basket

Instructions

Cast on 6 stitches on US11, using magic loop or dpns. Place a marker and begin working in the round.

Round 1: Kfb (12 sts)

Round 2 and all even rounds until round 16: Purl

Round 3: K1, Kfb; repeat to end of round (18 sts)

Round 5: K2, Kfb; repeat to end of round (24 sts)

Round 7: K3, Kfb; repeat to end of round (30 sts)

Round 9: K4, Kfb; repeat to end of round (36 sts)

Round 11: K5, Kfb; repeat to end of round (42 sts)

Round 13: K6, Kfb; repeat to end of round (48 sts)

Round 15: K7, Kfb; repeat to end of round (54 sts)

Round 16: K2tog, knit to end of round (53 sts)

Now you'll knit the rest of the basket. Start by removing the beginning of round marker, then repeat (P1, K3) until basket is desired height. Our sample is 8" tall.

Last Row: Bind off knitwise to last stitch. Cast on one stitch with knitted cast on. Knit 2, *slide to other end of needle and knit 2 repeat from * until you have a 3" long 2 stitch I-cord, k2tog, cut yarn and pull through last stitch.

Attach other end of I-cord to basket, weave in ends. Sew on button.



Materials

Yarn: 1 skein Berroco Macro; 112yd/250g or other Jumbo Yarn

Needle: US11 needles. 32" for magic loop or double points and 24".

Gauge and Size

9 sts x 15 rows to 4 inches.

8" Tall x 8" Diameter

Abbreviations

Kfb: Knit front back (increase 1)

K: Knit

P: Purl

K2tog: Knit next 2 stitches together (decrease 1)
