

10 Days Frida Hat/Cowl

Instructions

Hat/Cowl:

Using US 6 - 16" circular needle, cast on 96 sts. Place a BOR marker, slipping as you come to it. Begin working in the round.

Rounds 1- 34: Work a K2, P2 rib. Switch to the US8 - 16"

Rounds 35 +: Knit until it measures 12" from cast on edge.

Eyelet round: K2, yo, k2tog, K to last 4 sts, K2tog, yo, K2.

Folded Hem:

Knit until you've worked 1.5" past **Eyelet Round** (hint: measure from the top of your YOs).

Bind off loosely, leaving a long tail. Fold the bind off edge toward the inside (right side facing out) and sew to the row just below the eyelet row.

Drawstring I-Cord:

Using US 6 - 16" needles, cast on 3 sts. *K3, sl3pwise from right to left needle; repeat from * until I-cord measures approx. 36". Cut yarn, thread darning needle and draw through 3 sts, securing end of I-cord.

Weave in ends. Thread the drawstring through one eyelet and pull out through the other eyelet of the folded hem. Block.

Materials

Yarn: 1 skein of Lang *Frida*, 241 yds/100 grams.

OR approx. 240 yards of light worsted weight yarn.

Needles: US 6 - 16" and US 8 -16" circular needles

Notions: Marker, Darning needle

Gauge and Size

20sts x 28sts = 4" in stockinette stitch before blocking. Adult Size

Abbreviations

BOR= Beginning of round

K= Knit

 $\mathbf{P} = \text{Purl}$

sts = stitches

YO = yarn over (bring yarn forward between needles, then back over right needle)

K2tog = Knit the next 2 stitches together. 1 st decreased.

sl3pwise = slip 3 stitches to the other needle purl-wise, without working.

Hat/Cowl:
