

Just Right Ribbed Mitts

Instructions

Cast on 32 stitches. place a marker slipping as you come to it. Begin working in the round.

Round 1: *K2, P2; repeat from * around.

Repeat **Round 1** until piece measures approximately 3" from cast in edge.

On the final row, (K2, P2) x4, PM, K2, PM, (K2, P2) to end of round.

Thumb Gusset

Round 1: (K2, P2) to M, SM, M1R, K to next M, M1L, SM, P2, (K2, P2) to end of round.

Round 2: Knit.

Repeat Rounds 1 and 2 of gusset until you have 12 stitches between your markers.

Next round: (K2, P2) x4, remove M, place next 12 stitches on scrap yarn, cast on 2 stitches using backward loop cast on method, remove M, P2, (K2, P2) to end of round.

Continue in K2, P2 rib until piece measures 2" from top of thumb gusset. Bind off loosely in pattern.



Materials

Yarn: 1 ball Berroco *Millstone Tweed*, Aran weight, 97 yards **Needles:** US 7 - 24" for Magic

Loop, or DPNs

Notions: Darning needle, markers

Gauge and Size

5sts/inch, average adult

Abbreviations

K= Knit

 $\mathbf{P} = \text{Purl}$

PM = place marker

 $\mathbf{M} = \text{marker}$

SM = slip marker

M1R = make one stitch right

M1L = make one stitch left

Thumb

Pick up 12 held stitches and remove waste yarn. Join yarn and pick up 1 stitch on left side of backward loop cast on edge, K12, pick up 1 stitch on right side of backward loop cast on edge. PM for beginning of round.

K 6 rounds. Bind off loosely. Weave in ends and block.
