

Trio of Washcloths

Materials

Yarn: 1 ball Ella Rae *Pretty in Pima*, Worsted weight. 184 yards 100% pima cotton. Needles: US 7 - 24" for length Notions: Darning needle

Size

8 x 8 inches

Abbreviations

K= Knit **P** = Purl

Sl1wyif = Slip 1 stitch as if to purl with yarn in front.

sts = Stitches

K1B = Knit into the stitch 1 row below the one on the needle by inserting the needle from front to back. Knit this stitch, then pull the worked stitch and the stitch above off the needle together. **K2tog** = Knit the next 2 stitches

together. 1 stitch decreased.

YO = Bring the yarn under and over the righthand needle.

1 stitch increased.



Moss Stitch

Cast on 38 stitches.

Rows 1 and 2: Sl1wyif, K to end of row.

Row 3: (RS) Sl1wyif, K1, *K1, P1; repeat from * until 2 sts remain, K2.

Row 4: (WS) Sl1wyif, K1, *K1, P1; repeat from * until 2 sts remain, K2.

Row 5: Sl1wyif, K1, *P1, K1; repeat from * until 2 sts remain, K2.

Row 6: Sl1wyif, K1, *P1, K1; repeat from * until 2 sts remain, K2.

Repeat **Rows 3-6** until just shy of 8 inches.

Next 2 Rows: Sl1wyif, K to end of row.

Bind off and weave in ends.



Checkered Rib

Cast on 40 stitches. **Rows 1- 3:** Sl1wyif, K to end of row.

Row 4: Sl1wyif, K1, P until two sts remain, K2.

Row 5: (RS) Sl1wyif, K1, K1B, *P1, K2, P1, K1B; repeat from * until 2 sts remain, K2.

Row 6: (WS) Sl1wyif, K1, P1, *K1, P2, K1, P1; repeat from * until 2 sts remain, K2.

Row 7: Sl1wyif, K1, K1B, *P4, K1B; repeat from * until 2 sts remain, K2.

Row 8: Sl1wyif, K1, P1, *K4, P1; repeat from * until 2 sts remain, K2.

Repeat **Rows 5-8** until just shy of 8 inches.

Next 3 Rows: Sl1wyif, K to end of row.

Bind off and weave in ends.



Diagonal

Cast on 2 stitches. **Increase section:**

Row 1: Kfb, Kfb.

Row 2: Sl1wyif, K1, YO, K to end of row.

Repeat **Increase Row 2** until you have 50 sts on your needle.

Decrease section:

Row 1: Sl1wyif, K2tog, YO, K2tog, K to end of row.

Repeat **Decrease Row 1** until 4 sts remain.

Row 2: K2tog, K2tog.

Bind off and weave in ends.
