

Yep, That's It! Cowl

Instructions

Using *Cardo* or other bulky yarn, cast on 72 stitches. Place a marker slipping as you come to it. Begin working in the round.

Rounds 1 & 2: *K2, P2; repeat from * to end of around.

Round 3: *K2, P2; repeat from * until 4 stitches remain, K2, P2tog. Remove marker.

Next: *K3, P1; repeat from * until piece measures approx. 8" from cast on edge. You do not need to keep track of the beginning of the round; just keep *K3, P1* and...yep, that's it!

Last round: *k2tog, K1; repeat from * to end of around. 54 stitches remaining.

Cut yarn leaving a tail. Join *Furreal*. Place marker.

Next: Knit every round, until section measures approx. 7" from where you joined the fluffy yarn.

Bind off loosely. Weave in ends and block. Wear cowl folded in or open!

Materials

Yarn: 1 skein Manos del Uruguay Cardo Bulky weight, 109 yards

1 skein *Furreal* Super Bulky weight, 71 yards

Needles: US 13 - 24" circular **Notions:** Darning needle and marker

Gauge and Size

Approx. 11 sts x 15 rows = 4" in K3, P1 pattern, blocked.

Abbreviations

K= Knit

 $\mathbf{P} = Purl$

K2tog = Knit the next 2 stitches together. 1 stitch decreased.

P2tog = Purl the next 2 stitches together. 1 stitch decreased.

Yep, That's It! Cowl

Instructions

Using *Cardo* or other bulky yarn, cast on 72 stitches. Place a marker slipping as you come to it. Begin working in the round.

Rounds 1 & 2: *K2, P2; repeat from * to end of around.

Round 3: *K2, P2; repeat from * until 4 stitches remain, K2, P2tog. Remove marker.

Next: *K3, P1; repeat from * until piece measures approx. 8" from cast on edge. You do not need to keep track of the beginning of the round; just keep *K3, P1* and...yep, that's it!

Last round: *k2tog, K1; repeat from * to end of around. 54 stitches remaining.

Cut yarn leaving a tail. Join *Furreal*. Place marker.

Next: Knit every round, until section measures approx. 7" from where you joined the fluffy yarn.

Bind off loosely. Weave in ends and block. Wear cowl folded in or open!

Materials

Yarn: 1 skein Manos del Uruguay Cardo Bulky weight, 109 yards

1 skein *Furreal* Super Bulky weight, 71 yards

Needles: US 13 - 24" circular **Notions:** Darning needle and

marker

Gauge and Size

Approx. 11 sts x 15 rows = 4" in K3, P1 pattern, blocked.

Abbreviations

K= Knit

 $\mathbf{P} = Purl$

K**2tog** = Knit the next 2 stitches together. 1 stitch decreased.

P2tog = Purl the next 2 stitches together. 1 stitch decreased.
