



Our Nanny's Granny Square Poncho

Instructions

Begin with a magic circle. OR Chain 3, sl st in 1st chain to create a ring

Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as st), 1 dc in ring, ch 1, *2 dc in ring, ch 1, repeat from * 3 times more, join in top of beg ch, fasten off CA, tighten magic circle.

Round 2: Join CB in any ch 1 sp, ch 3 (counts as st), [1 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in same ch 1 sp, *ch 1 [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next ch 1 sp, rep from * twice more, ch 1 and join in top of beg ch, fasten off CB.

Round 3: Join CC in any ch 2 corner sp, ch 3 (counts as st), [1 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in same ch 2 space, *[ch 1, 2 dc] in next ch 1 sp, [ch 1, 2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next ch 2 corner sp, rep from * 3 times total, ch 1, 2 dc in next sp, ch 1, join in top of beg ch, fasten off CC.

Round 4: Join MC in any ch 2 corner sp, ch 3 (counts as st), [1 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in same ch 2 space, *[ch 1, 2 dc] in next ch 1 sp, [ch 1, 2 dc] in next ch 1 sp, [ch 1, 2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in next ch 2 corner sp, rep from * 3 times total, 2 dc in next sp, ch 1, join in top of beg ch, fasten off MC.

You will need 4 assembled large squares made up of 9 Granny Squares each (36 squares total). Individual Granny Squares are whipped stitch together or use your favorite method to join.

Recommend weaving in ends as you go, as well as laying out your 9 patch squares prior to seaming.

To change size: Add additional rounds and/or additional granny squares. This may require additional yarn.



Materials

Yarn: 3 skeins MC, 6 contrasting colors of Simplicity for smaller size; Hikoo *Simplicity*, 117 yards 50 grams / 2 skeins of MC and 5 contrasting colors; Hikoo Simplicworsted 140 yds & 100g

Hook: D/ H

Notions: 1 stitch marker, darning needle.

Gauge and Size

Toddler/ Small Child

Granny Square finished size 3.25"x3.25" for toddler, 3.75"x3.75" for small child size

Abbreviations

Ch = Chain

Dc = Double crochet

Sp = Space

CA = Color A

CB = Color B

CC = Color C

MC = Main Color

Notes

The 4 assembled squares will make the shape of an L. 3 squares tall and 1 across. Then sewn the top of the L with the right side of the L together to create the Poncho :)
