



Garden Path

Bag

Using a Turkish cast-on, CO 88 stitches (44 per needle) and work in Magic loop technique on longer needles or CO 88 stitches using a long tail cast on with 16" circulars and leave a long tail for seaming. Place markers at BOR and halfway point and begin working in the round. If starting with the Turkish cast-on, switch to 16 inch circular after increases are complete.

Round 1-2: Knit.

Round 3: *K1, M1R, K to 1 stitch before marker, M1L, K1, repeat from * to end of round. (4 sts increased)

Round 4: Knit.

Round 5-14: Repeat **Rounds 3-4** (112 stitches total). Continue to **Round 15** below.

Cowl

Cast on 128 stitches, place marker, and begin knitting in the round.

Rounds 1 - 14: Twisted Rib, *K2tbl, P2; repeat from * to end of round.

Bag & Cowl

Round 15-17: Purl.

Round 18: *P1, K1, P1 in the same stitch, K3tog; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 19: Purl.

Round 20: *K3tog, P1, K1, P1 in the same stitch; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 21-28: Repeat **Rounds 17-20** twice.

Round 29-31: Purl.

Round 32-39: Knit.

Rounds 40-41: Purl.

Rounds 42: Knit.

Rounds 43-46: *P4, K4; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 47-50: *K4, P4; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 51-58: Repeat **Rounds 43-50** once.

Round 59: Knit.

Materials

Yarn: 1 skein Miss Babbs Killington 350yds/120g or other DK weight yarn. Makes either the bag or cowl.

Needles:

Bag

US6 needles. 32" for Turkish Cast on and magic loop technique, or 16" circular for long tail cast on.

Cowl

US6 24" circular

Notions: Stitch markers

Gauge and Size

Gauge:

20 sts x 28 rows = 4" stockinette

Size:

Bag 11" w x 12" high - measured flat
Cowl 12" w x 13" high - measured flat

Abbreviations

CO: Cast On

BOR: Beginning of round

K: Knit

P: Purl

tbl: Knit stitch through back loop

M1R: Make one Right

M1L: Make one Left

K3tog: Knit next 3 stitches together

BO: Bind Off

Rounds 60-61: Purl.

Rounds 62-69: Knit.

Rounds 70-71: Purl.

Round 72: Knit.

Round 73: *K1, P1; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 74-76: *K3, P1; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 77-85: Repeat **Rounds 72-76** once, then **Rounds 72-74** once more.

Round 86-87: Purl.

Continue to **Round 88** of either Cowl or Bag below.

Cowl

Rounds 88-94: Knit.

Rounds 95-96: Purl.

Rounds 97-110: Repeat **Rounds 18 - 31** once.

Rounds 111-124: Twisted Rib, *K2 TBL, P2; repeat from * to end of round.

Bind off. Weave in ends and block if desired.

Bag

I-cord Casing

Round 88: Knit to the last 2 stitches, BO last 2 stitches of this round and first 2 stitches of next round.

You will now be working in rows.

Row 89: Knit.

Row 90: Purl.

Row 91-94: Repeat **Rows 89-90** twice.

Row 95: Purl, when you reach the end of the row CO 2 stitches, place BOR marker, CO 2 stitches and join to work in the round.

Round 96-101: Knit.

Bind off in pattern, fasten off leaving a tail that is ~3 times the circumference of the top of the bag.

Fold top of bag at purl round and using a whip stitch seam the bind off round to the first knit round to create a casing for the drawstring.

Weave in ends and block if desired. Make Drawstring.

I-Cord Drawstring

- Cast on three stitches on circular needle or DPN.
- Knit one row.
- Do not turn, slide stitches to the other end of the needle.
- Knit across bringing yarn behind the work.
- Repeat last two steps until your icord is ~24 inches long.
- Bind off.
- Weave in ends.

Alternatively, you could use cording or a ribbon as a drawstring.

Thread I-cord through casing on bag and knot ends if desired.
