



Zig Zag Hat

Worsted

Instructions

Cast on 80 stitches. Place a beginning-of-the-round marker and begin working in the round.

Round 1 & 3: *Purl 3, slip 1 stitch with yarn in back (sl1wyib); repeat from * to end of round.

Round 2: *Knit 3, Sl1wyib; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 4: *Slip 3 stitches as if to purl from left needle to right needle, hold the next stitch (this will be the stitch you slipped each round) to the front of your work, no need to use a cable needle, it should be ok just hanging out. Slip the 3 stitches back to the left needle, and put the dropped slip stitch back on the left needle, knit 4; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 5 & 7: *Sl1wyib, purl 3; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 6: *Sl1wyib, knit 3; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 8: *Drop slipped stitch off of the left hand needle to the front of work, knit next 3 stitches, then put dropped stitch back on the left hand needle and knit it; repeat from * to end of round.

Work rounds 1-8 until you have completed 9 repeats. You should have about 5-6 yards remaining.

Crown of Hat

Decrease Round 1: *Purl 2 together, purl 1, knit 1; repeat from * to end of round. (60 stitches)

Decrease Round 2: *Knit 2 together, knit 1; repeat from * to end of round. (40 stitches)

Decrease Round 3: *Knit 2 together; repeat from * to end of round. (20 stitches)

Decrease Final Round: Remove marker, *knit 2 together; repeat until you have 8 stitches left.

Thread yarn through the remaining 8 stitches and cinch closed. Weave in ends. Add Pom Pom.



Materials

Yarn: 1 skein Berroco Mirelle, 152 yards/100 grams

Needles: US8 16" circular, US8 DPNs

Notions: tapestry needle, stitch marker

Gauge: 19 stitches = 4"

Size

This hat fits an average sized adult head. 20 - 23".
