



## Just a Blankie

Everything is popping up baby at Darn Knit this summer. Three grandbabies are arriving to our Rockstar Team and it's full-time baby knitting around here.

This is the perfect baby blankie for a new momma. Small, perfect for a stroller or car seat, perfect for a little one to carry around as a lovey too!

Oh, and Berroco Remix is machine washable!  
What's not to love?



## Instructions

This blanket is knit in the round from the center outward. You can use double pointed needles or a long circular needle and magic loop technique to begin this blanket. Switch to longer circular needles as needed. We knit the entire blanket on a US47 and magic loop technique.

Cast on 8 stitches. Join for working in round, placing BOR marker.

**Set Up Round 1:** KFB in each stitch (16 stitches)

**Set Up Round 2:** Knit

**Set Up Round 3:** Knit

**Set up Round 4:** Remove BOR marker, K3, replace BOR marker, M5, (K3, PM, M5) x 3, knit to beginning of round.

**Rounds 1 – 3:** Knit all stitches, slipping markers as you come to them.

**Round 4:** Remove BOR marker, K2, replace BOR marker, M5, (knit to next marker, remove marker, K2, PM, M5) x 3. Knit to BOR.

**Round 5 – 7:** (K5, purl to marker, SM) x 4

**Round 8:** Remove BOR marker, K2, replace BOR marker, M5 (knit to next marker, remove marker, K2, replace marker, M5) x 3. Knit to BOR.

Repeat rounds 1 – 8, 9 more times.

**Final Repeat Rounds 1 & 2:** Knit all stitches, slipping markers as you come to them.

**Final Repeat Rounds 3 & 4:** (K5, purl to marker, SM) x 4.

Bind off purlwise on round 5.

Weave in ends, block, and put a baby on it.

## Materials

**Yarn:** Berroco Remix. 216 yards/100 grams. 2 skeins.

**Needles:** US7 – 47" circular

**Notions:** 4 stitch markers, 1 of them unique for beginning of round.

## Size & Gauge

17 sts = 4" on a US7 in Stockinette Stitch  
It's just a blankie...gauge doesn't really matter 😊

24" square, blocked.

## Abbreviations

**K**=knit

**KFB** = knit into the front and back of same stitch (increase 1)

**PM**= place marker

**BOR** = beginning of round

**M5** = (K1, yarn over, K1, yarn over, k1) into same stitch (increase 4)

**SM**=slip marker
