



Jul's Yuletide Hat

Instructions

Cast on 72 stitches. Place a beginning-of-round marker and begin working in the round. Work from chart, or written instructions as follows.

Round 1 - 10: *K1 with MC, P1 with CC; repeat from * until end of the round.

Round 11 - 12: Knit with MC.

Round 13 - 29: Work colorwork chart (chart repeats 9 times).

Break MC.

Round 30 - 31: Knit with CC.

Crown Decreases

Round 32: *K2tog, K4, SSK; repeat from * until end of the round.

Round 33: Knit around.

Round 34: *K2tog, K2, SSK; repeat from * until end of the round.

Round 35: Knit around.

Round 36: *K2tog, SSK; repeat from * until end of the round.

Round 37: Knit around.

Round 38: K2tog; repeat from * until end of the round.

Cut CC leaving 8" tail, with tapestry needle weave yarn through remaining stitches and weave in ends.



Materials

- Yarn:** 2 balls of Germantown Bulky, 123 yards/100 grams (one ball of two colors)
- Needles:** US 10.5 16" circular and US 10.5 DPNs or 32" circular for Magic Loop
- Notions:** tapestry needle, stitch marker
- Gauge:** 15 sts = 4"

Size

This hat fits an average sized adult head. 20 - 23". To knit a smaller size you can decrease the cast on in multiples of 8 stitches and to make a larger hat, you can cast on extra stitches in multiples of 8.

Abbreviations

- K Knit
- P Purl
- / k2tog (knit 2 together)
- \ SSK (slip, slip, knit)
- MC (Main Color)
- CC (Contrast Color)
